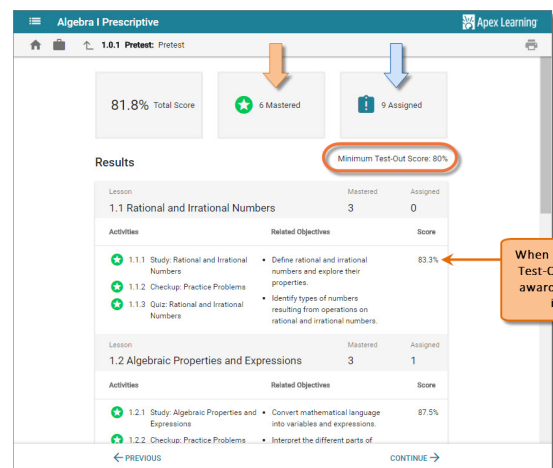
Focus Student Effort with Personalized Learning Plans

An individualized learning plan is automatically generated based on pretest results to direct each student to the specific material they have yet to master. The plan is represented visually in the course outline so that each student can clearly see their individualized path.

Although the course outline highlights the content a student needs to complete, the entire course is always available for the student to access. Individualized learning plans efficiently guide a student's learning, ensuring educators that students are focused on the material they have yet to master.
