Determine who will use digital curriculum and how it will be employed at your school or district

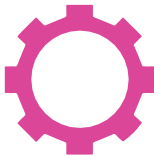
Know Where You Are Going

Develop program vision and goals

Make a Plan

Create a program plan that includes an implementation schedule and required resources

PREPARE



Get Set Up

Create staff and student accounts and classrooms, and train staff

Create Policies and Procedures

Prepare program guidelines for staff roles, student participation, and classroom configuration

Gather Resources

Schedule and identify staff, technology, and materials for each program

DEVELOP AND EVALUATE



Launch Program

Conduct orientations to prepare students and set clear expectations

Monitor Students & Staff

Understand how program participants are performing, celebrate strengths, and address weaknesses

Track Program Goals

Evaluate program success by tracking progress toward previously established goals
